Safety Guidelines

For small engine displays:

- 1) Double rope stanchions separating the displayed items from the public by a minimum of three (3) feet.
- 2) Occupancy of the display area shall be at the discretion of the exhibitor/owner.
- 3) Person attending engines & equipment to have control at all times.
- 4) Running engine or equipment shall NOT be left unattended.
- 5) Safety officer has the right to shut down any display running unattended or running unsafely.
- 6) Fuel will be stored in a closed container at least SIX (6) FEET away from the nearest running engine.
- 7) It is suggested that exhibits with running engines have easy access to a fire extinguisher located away from fuel container.
- 8) All engines & equipment have sufficient area to allow the operator easy access to all items, and a safe operation shall be maintained at all times.
- 9) All exhibits with wheels parked on uneven ground shall have wheels blocked to prevent rolling.
- 10) Keep area free of clutter.
- 11) All fuel leaks should have a flat tray containing cat-litter to catch any leaking fuel.

Strongly desired:

- 1) Exhaust should be directed away from the viewing public.
- 2) Belts should run parallel to the public.
- 3) First aid kit on hand.

Stationary equipment such as husker shredder, thresher, rock crusher, saw mill, etc.:

If there is a piece of equipment that a child could get their fingers in it needs to be roped off.

Tractors:

- 1) Owner/operator must be in attendance when tractor is running.
- 2) Only the operator of the tractor may be on said tractor while moving unless a provision for riders is provided.
- 3) Oil or fuel leaks should have a flat tray with cat-litter to catch leaks.
